Writing 39C papers should emphasize research strategies, as well as argumentation, logic, and inquiry.

Your petition will be reviewed by a Composition Course Director; please allow several weeks for a response during busy periods. We will contact you via e-mail when a decision has been made regarding your petition, and we will send a copy to your major's academic counseling office.
