PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING TA RULES.

- 1). You must have graduate GPA of at least 3.1. Please attach latest transcript to your application.
- 2). Please do not apply if you expect to have GSR appointment in fall 2004.
- 3). If you receive fellowship stipend, you are not eligible for teaching assistantship.
- 4). Foreign students or domestic students not receiving four years of high school education in USA must have taken and passed the TSE, SPEAK or TOEP before filling out an application. Passing scores are 50 for TSE & Speak and 5 for the TOEP.
- 5). Even though you have applied for a TA position, it is YOUR responsibility to pay your fees and tuition on time. If you are hired as a TA, you will be reimbursed for the majority portion of your fees, but you will still be responsible for the un-reimbursed portion, which is approximately \$167.50. The teaching assistantship does not pay the tuition (non-resident tuition). You will be responsible for any and all late fees.

Application deadline is August 27, 2004. Please be aware that TA positions available in Fall 2004 are very limited.
