## **SWE-OC Undergraduate Student Scholarship**

The Society of Women Engineers Orange County Section (SWE-OC) was organized in 1983 and chartered in 1985. SWE-OC is a volunteer, nonprofit, educational, service organization whose members support the advancement of women in engineering. Through the generous support of businesses and individuals, scholarships are awarded to women pursuing undergraduate studies in the field of engineering at universities supported by SWE-OC.

SWE-OC will award two Undergraduate Scholarship(s) in the amounts of \$1,250 (1st place) and \$750 (2nd Place). The **minimum criteria for selection** are as follows:

- **Female student at:**  
**CSU Fullerton, CSU Long Beach, UC Irvine, UC Riverside, Santa Ana College, Cal Baptist University, Chaffey College, or Cypress College.**
- **Enrolled in an undergraduate degree program in an engineering field, such as Electrical, Mechanical or Civil Engineering.**
- **GPA of 3.0 or higher**
- **Plans to pursue a career in an engineering field**

Evaluation will be based on academic performance, work experience, community involvement, letter of recommendation, and evidence of leadership, motivation, character and self-reliance.

The recipients of each scholarship will be announced at the SWE-OC Awards and Recognition Banquet held in May 2018.
